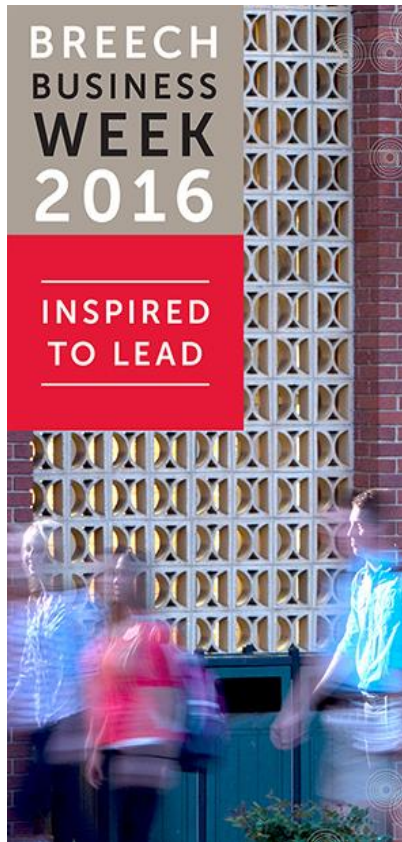


Breech Business Week
