JOB TITLE: Event Staff Level II -Live Broadcast Video Technician

JOB FUNCTION: Operate a camera and monitor live video feed for sports broadcasts on the Great Lakes Valley Conference Sports Network

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

This job description is not to be construed as an exhaustive statement of duties, responsibilities or requirements. Employees may be required to perform other job-related instructions as requested by the supervisor, subject to reasonable accommodation.

1. 80%	As assigned	The job would require working a camera to follow game action, monitor and potentially troubleshoot issues on the broadcast through a live media encoder on a laptop. In addition, assistance in the set-up and tear-down of broadcast equipment would also be required.
2. 20%	As needed	Performs a variety of set up and tear down functions of broadcast equipment.

MINIMUM KNOWLEDGE SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. All job requirements listed indicate the minimum knowledge, skills, and/or ability deemed necessary to perform the job proficiently. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

1. Ability to follow instructions and perform job under a variety of lead supervisors.
2. Ability to work with technicians by phone to adjust or troubleshoot any technical issues with the broadcast.
3. Must represent the O'Reilly Family Event Center in a positive manner and be able to respond to customer requests or questions.
4. Must be prepared to work outside during inclement weather if assigned to certain positions.
5. Must be a regular, full-time day school student, enrolled in at least 12 hours per semester.

WORKING CONDITIONS:
