### \*Breach Admission Requirements:

To be admitted to the Breach School, a student must: 1) be officially admitted to Drury University; 2) complete an official declaration of major form; 3) have completed at least 42 hours of college level credit, including a minimum of 12 semester hours at Drury; 4) have completed preparatory courses with a minimum grade of C- (For 2011-2012, those courses are: ACCT 209, CISQ 170, CISQ 250, ECON 201, MATH 227, plus MATH 230 or MATH 231); have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on all Drury coursework. (Note: If a student has earned a grade less than C- in any of the preparatory courses and has a cumulative GPA of less than 2.75, they are not eligible to apply for conditional admission.) Students are advised to check the admission policy requirements in the catalog for the year they are following.
