

## Crime Alert Log for 2015

### 11/06/2015 Larceny from Motor Vehicles

On November 5, 2015, a Summit Park resident discovered their personal vehicle had been rummaged through but nothing was taken and there were no signs of forced entry. At 8:35 pm, November 4, 2015, security has video of a W/M, thin build, approx. 5'11, wearing blue jeans, dark colored hoodie, checking car doors in the Summit Park apartments parking lot.

Security has had two other reports of similar incidents, October 25<sup>th</sup>, a car's window was broken out but nothing was taken, the car was parked on Calhoun street. On October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015 in Lot 7 a car was rummaged through, the only thing taken was an envelope and there were no signs of forced entry. There is no video of either incident.

### 10/01/15 Bicycle Thefts

Over the past three weeks Drury campus has experienced several bicycle thefts. Some of these bikes have been locked to bike racks and some have not. The thefts have occurred all over campus, in front of academic buildings as well as in the residential areas. Please remember to always lock your bike to a bike rack (not to a tree, hand rail, or light post) and to check on it regularly. Some of the better bicycle locks are the "Kryptonite New York Standard", "On Guard 8020", "Hiplock Chain Lock" and various "U Locks".
