



## ENTRY FORM

Thank you for entering the 2010 Study Abroad Photo Contest! Your photos will be evaluated by a team of judges from across campus. All photos will be displayed in Findlay Student Center during International Education Week (Nov. 15-19). Winning photographs will be displayed at Study Abroad Fairs, included in future DU publications/videos, and showcased on the DU website. By entering the contest you will be giving DU permission to use your photo(s) in various marketing activities, publications, and/or on the Web for the purpose of promoting study abroad at Drury University. This means all photos, not just winning entries, will be eligible for inclusion in such activities.

**To enter, read the rules of the contest below, complete the form on the back, and return the form with your photo(s) by Wednesday, November 10, 2010, to FSC 203 or PAC 201.**

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

Entrants must be students who have participated in, and earned credit in, a DU-sponsored study abroad program. Photos must be the original work and have been taken by the entrant during the entrant's study abroad program or by another participant on the entrant's program. A maximum of **three** photos may be submitted per entrant.

**PRINTS will not be returned** and must include the following labeled on the back of each photo:  
(please do not use markers)

- ✓ Photos may be color, black & white, or sepia and must be submitted **both as 8" x 10" print and as a digital image** (so that photo can be added to Study Abroad web page).
- ✓ Entrant's name and ID number
- ✓ Title of photo
- ✓ Please identify any Drury student(s) in photo – be sure you have their permission
- ✓ Location and date of the photo (be as specific as possible)
- ✓ Digital image (300 dpi or higher) can be submitted on disk or emailed to [candrews@drury.edu](mailto:candrews@drury.edu).

**Entries must be received no later than 5:00 p.m., November 10, 2010,** to the Office of International Programs in FSC 203 or Office of Study Abroad Programs in Pool Art Center 201.

### **AWARDS**

Winning entries will be selected based on the best quality photographs in the three categories – People, Places, Culture. The criteria for each category are as follows:

**PEOPLE:** Photos should capture images of students interacting with local populations and should portray the essence of the entrant's study abroad experience

**PLACES:** Photos should be of a landmark or landscape that is clearly identifiable as an international location.

**CULTURE:** Photos should express defining moments or interaction with host culture.

Winners will be notified by email in mid-November and will be officially announced during International Education Week. Only one award per entrant will be given. **Battlefield Mall Gift Certificates** will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners in each category as well as one overall "Grand Prize" Winner. Prizes: **1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$30.00** (in each category), **2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$20.00** (in each category), **Overall Grand Prize: \$75.00. All photos (both winners and non-winners) will become the property of the Office of Study Abroad Programs and will not be returned.**
