MEDICAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM

About the Program

University of Missouri-Kansas City (UMKC) partners with Drury University to offer early, guaranteed admission to its M.D. program. Drury students apply to UMKC either between their sophomore and junior years or between their junior and senior years. Accepted students will begin studying at UMKC the January following graduation from Drury.

Admission Guidelines

- Students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 at the end of the second year.
- Students must earn a B- or better in all science courses.
- Students are expected to have shadowing experience of approximately 135 hours prior to the interview.
- Students must submit an application by August 1st. The application will be available May 1st.
- If invited for an interview, students must interview in person at the UMKC School of Medicine in September or October.
- Applicants will receive notification of acceptance in November.

- Students must have a combined MCAT score of 500 or higher.
- Accepted students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 for all four years of undergraduate work.

Only one student is accepted from each partner school.

Applicants must have completed the following courses prior to acceptance into the Scholars Program:

The application for admission to the Medical Scholars Program includes:

- Personal statement.
- Program application.
- Resume highlighting healthcare experiences.
- Three letters of recommendation, including at least one from a faculty member.
- Official college transcripts.
