

The Scholars Programs

The Medical Scholars Program

The Benefits

- Allows students to focus solely on their undergraduate education.
- The programs are non-binding. Students can exit whenever they want to, but guaranteed acceptance is forfeited.

Saint Louis University

Eligibility

- ACT composite of at least 30 or 1330 SAT score.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 for all four years and not receive a D or F in any class.
- Completed 135 hours of shadowing experience.

Additional Requirements

- Attend an interview at SLU.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- Students are expected to sit through the MCAT but there is not a minimum required score.

Kirkville College of Osteopathic Medicine

Eligibility

- A cumulative and science GPA of 3.4.
- Completed 75% of pre-requisite courses prior to applying to the program.
- Earn a B or above in all pre-requisite courses.
- Completed 135 hours of shadowing experience.

Additional Requirements

- Interview with the KCOM selection committee.
- Accepted students must maintain a 3.4 GPA.

University of Missouri- Bryant Scholars

Eligibility

- ACT composite score of 28 or higher or equivalent SAT score.
- Overall high school GPA of 3.5.
- Reside in a rural Missouri community of less than 18,000 citizens.
- Are committed to practicing medicine in rural Missouri.

Additional Requirements

- Must interview with a MU faculty committee.
- Accepted students must maintain science and cumulative GPAs of 3.3 or greater and receive a B or higher in required courses.
- Must score at least a 27 on the MCAT.

Kansas City University of Medicine and Bioscience

Eligibility

- ACT composite score of 28 or higher or an equivalent SAT score.
- Minimum science GPA of 3.5 and 3.25 cumulative GPA after their first year at Drury.

Additional Requirements

- Interview with the Drury Pre-Medical Committee and a KCUMB representative in the spring of their second year.
- Matriculate to KCUMB after their third year.
- Maintain 3.5 science GPA and 3.25 overall GPA during the second and third years.

University of Missouri- Kansas City

Eligibility

- A cumulative GPA of 3.5 and a science GPA of 3.5 in all of the pre-requisite courses at the end of the second year.
- Students must obtain a B- or greater in these required courses.
- Completed 135 hours of shadowing experience.

Additional Requirements

- Complete an application and turn it in prior to September 1st of their third or fourth year at Drury.
- Attend an interview at the UMKC School of Medicine during September-October of their third or fourth years at Drury.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.5 for all four years of undergraduate school.
- Obtain a cumulative MCAT score of 26 or higher.

The Physical Therapy Scholars Program

The Benefits

- Students have a reserved seat in the DPT class.
- Students accepted into the program will receive preference during admissions.

Southwest Baptist University

Eligibility

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75.
- A cumulative 3.0 GPA in all the pre-requisite courses and at least a C or better in each of these courses.

Additional Requirements

- Complete up to 40 hours of shadowing experience in physical therapy.
- Demonstrate computer literacy.
- Complete the GRE.

The Master of Science in Anesthesia Scholars Program

University of Missouri- Kansas City

Eligibility

- Obtain a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher and a GPA of 3.0 in the pre-requisite courses.
- Students must earn a B- in the pre-requisite courses.

Additional Requirements

- Complete the MCAT.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher.
- Interview at UMKC in the fall semester of their third or fourth year.
- Earn a baccalaureate degree prior to entering the School of Medicine MSA program.
