3. Please estimate a total budget for your course, assuming no more than 16 students. The base class budget, set by the Pre-College Board, is \$125. This should include any supply expenses, field-trip entry fees, and the bus rental for a field trip (\$35 per hour).

4. Write a 75-100 word course description, complete with title of the course that you would like printed in the advertising brochure. Please write this directed to the students since they will be the ones choosing the course. Keep in mind the age of the student. Make the class description and title intrigue them and appeal to their current interests.
5. Please explain facility requirements for your course. For example, will you need sinks, computers, overhead projector, TV etc.
6. Do you have a state background check on-file with your school district?

2. Have you had experience in teaching gifted/talented students? If so, please describe, telling, when, where, and for how long.
