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Drury University offers undergraduate, graduate, and post-baccalaureate educator preparation programs that lead to professional educator certification in the State of Missouri. All educator certification programs are approved by the Missouri State Board of Education and meet the state's standards for educator preparation.

Because educator licensure and certification requirements vary by state and territory, completion of a Missouri-approved educator preparation program does not automatically qualify graduates for certification in another state. Many states participate in reciprocity agreements that make transferring a teaching credential relatively straightforward, although additional coursework, examinations, or other requirements may apply.

Students who plan to seek educator certification or licensure outside of Missouri are encouraged to contact the University's **Certification Officer** early in their program to discuss the requirements of the state or territory in which they intend to practice. Please note that states use different terminology, with some referring to **licensure** and others to **certification**, and requirements are subject to change.

Because state requirements may change without notice, prospective and current students are strongly encouraged to review the official educator licensure website for the state or territory in which they plan to seek employment.
