

Transfer Students and the History Major

Two-year Plan:

Students should take the sophomore level writing and research class that is offered in the spring semester. They should work to fulfill the area categories depending on which classes have been previously fulfilled. They should take senior capstone, after fulfilling their 200 level writing class, and their 300 level classes for the major, in the fall of the last semester.

Three-year Plan:

Students should take the sophomore level writing and research class that is offered in the spring semester. They should work to fulfill the area categories as necessary.

Four-year Plan:

Students should follow the trajectory for the history major. Make sure to get your transfer credits finalized with the university so the department knows which areas have been fulfilled.
