## **Philosophy Major: Graduation Plan**

Four-year Plan

This is a suggestive plan for students who major in Philosophy.

Students should complete the introductory courses and at least three 300-level courses before taking the Senior Research Capstone: HPRL493. Students should take HPRL493 in the fall of the last semester before graduating.

<u>Year Two</u> Fall Semester PHIL305, 309, 310, 316, 320: Ethics PHIL 300 or 313: Ancient Greek to Medieval Or Modern Philosophy

<u>Year Three</u> Fall Semester PHIL 300 or 313 Non-Western Courses Spring Semester PHIL100: Intro to Logic
