

Modern Healthcare Certificate

Drury University's Modern Healthcare Certificate was established as an interdisciplinary four-course program of study using BIOL 145: Pathways and Opportunities in Healthcare, BADM 240: Healthcare Operations, PHIL 305: Ethical Issues in Healthcare, and the capstone course BIOL 440: Issues and Innovations in Healthcare.

The modern healthcare system is a complex interaction of scientific advances, interpersonal relationships between healthcare workers and their patients, and the business of healthcare operations. Many professional careers directly or indirectly engage with the healthcare system, and this certificate aims to provide students with an understanding of the scientific, ethical, and business variables necessary for success in the system.
