Study abroad is required of all Breech students. To earn credit for a study abroad trip, students must register for BADM 205/206/207/208 during the semester or term of their trip. **Students may not register for study abroad credit after their trip.**

Once approved, and once registration for your trip’s term is open, the Breech office will open a seat for you in the appropriate BADM section. **It is then your responsibility to register for the course. <p><input type="checkbox"/> BADM 205: Study Abroad</p> <p>This study abroad is a minimum of 21 days and requires formal enrollment in a university study abroad program in any academic area.</p> <p>Upon completion of the study abroad trip, you will reflect in writing on your experience, as well as on insights gained in a global business environment.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> BADM 206: Study Abroad Business/Leadership</p> <p>This study abroad is a minimum of 14 days and requires formal enrollment in a university program with a focus on global business.</p> <p>Upon completion of the study abroad trip, you will write a report in which you compare business/leadership in the U.S. with those of the country visited. You will also reflect on the interpersonal interactions with residents of the host country.</p>
<p><input type="checkbox"/> BADM 207: Study Abroad Service Learning</p> <p>This study abroad is a minimum of 7 days and requires affiliation with a formal agency, organization, or University sponsorship. A student may not complete this program on an individual basis.</p> <p>Upon completion of the study abroad trip, you will reflect in writing on</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The impact of a global business environment on the community visited, • The goal of the trip and its outcomes • Any lessons learned from the socio-cultural interactions during the experience. <p><i>Note: In many cases, student will enroll in BADM 207 class the semester after the trip.</i></p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> BADM 208: Study Abroad International Student</p> <p>International students studying business at Drury can fulfill their study abroad requirement with this course.</p> <p>Students are required to write a paper reflecting upon the global business experiences and insights gained from their study in the U.S.</p>
