- 6. Do you have a state background check on-file with your school district?
- 7. Why are you interested in working in the Pre-College Program?
- 8. Have you had experience in teaching gifted/talented students? If so, please describe, telling, when, where, and for how long.
- 9. What does "gifted" mean to you?
- 10. REFERENCES. Give names, addresses and telephone numbers of four persons who have firsthand knowledge about your training, experience, and other qualifications for the position you are seeking. The selection committee may contact these individuals.
