### Associate of Arts in General Studies Offered through Drury University's Dual Credit Program Core Requirement Sheet: Minimum 62 Credit Hours

- All courses offered for the AA in General Studies can be taken ONLINE or SEATED through Drury's Dual Credit Program.
- Students work with their high school counselor, the Drury Dual Credit Director, Beth Nation at completing the degree requirements.
- A Drury GO Academic Advisor will be assigned to the student the spring of their senior year and complete a degree audit to ensure degree requirements have been met.
- The Natural Science credits may be met through a Dual Credit science course/s offered at the student's high school if a course/s is taught seated.
- Textbooks/materials are provided at no charge to the student for each course and are linked in the course syllabus.
  - The EXCEPTION is for all MATH courses.
  - Online textbooks for MATH must be purchased through Pearson MyMathLab.
