- Friday, September 1, 2023 - Last day to ADD a course. Last day to DROP a course and receive a 100% refund.
- Monday, October 16, 2023 – Mid-terms grades due at 8 AM.
- October 14 – 22, 2023: Online Course Break - NO ONLINE COURSES.
- Friday, November 17, 2023 - Last day to WITHDRAW. No refund. Family must pay in full; “W” appears on transcript (does not affect Drury GPA).

Students may not choose their instructor when multiple instructors teach a single course. High schools and home school students have been pre-assigned for organization & communication purposes.
