Fall 2024 ONLINE Courses

Registration for Summer ONLINE courses will open on Monday, April 1, 2024.

All DC registrations occur in DualEnroll.

New DC students must fill out the Drury DC application; returning DC students go to DualEnroll and register.

Students will be using CANVAS for all DC, ONLINE courses.

- Fall 2024 online courses officially begin Monday August 19, 2024.
- Friday, August 30, 2024 - Last day to ADD a course. Last day to DROP a course and receive a 100% refund.
- Monday, October 7, 2024 – Mid-terms grades due at 8 AM.
- October 12-20, 2024: Online Course Break - NO ONLINE COURSES.
- Friday, November 15, 2024 - Last day to WITHDRAW. No refund. Family must pay in full; “W” appears on transcript (does not affect Drury GPA).

*Students may not choose their instructor when multiple instructors teach a single course. High schools and home school students have been pre-assigned for organization & communication purposes.

Math courses are returning to MyMathLab, an online text. Families are responsible for the cost of the course and the online text.
