The requirements for enrollment in a Drury Dual Credit course are as follows:

- <u>Students in the 11th and 12th grades</u> with an overall minimum grade point average of **3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)** are automatically eligible for dual credit courses.
- <u>Students in the 11th and 12th grades</u> with an overall grade point average between 2.5 2.99 (on a 4.0 scale) must have this letter of recommendation signed by the student, their parent/guardian, and the guidance counselor.
- <u>Students in the 9th and 10th grades</u> must have an overall grade point average of **3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)** and must have this letter of recommendation signed by the student, their parent/guardian, and their guidance counselor.

Drury University's Dual Credit Program requires permission from the student and their family, along with the high school counselor to take a dual credit course:

- If the student is a junior or a senior and has between a 2.5 and 2.99 GPA.
- If the student is a freshman or a sophomore and has below a 3.0.
