Spring 2023 ONLINE Courses

Registration for Fall ONLINE courses will open on Monday, October 31, 2022.

Students will be using CANVAS for all ONLINE courses.

- **Spring 2023 online courses officially begin Tuesday, January 17, 2023.**
- **Friday, January 27, 2023** - Last day to ADD a course. Last day to DROP a course and receive a 100% refund.
- **Monday, March 6, 2023** – Mid-terms grades due at 8 AM.
- **March 11-19, 2023:** Online Course Break - NO ONLINE COURSES.
- **Friday, April 14, 2023** - Last day to WITHDRAW. No refund. Family must pay in full; “W” appears on transcript (does not affect Drury GPA).
- **Monday, May 15, 2023:** Final grades due at 8AM.
- **Payment: ALL payment is handled through DualEnroll**, the company used for the registration process. Drury University no longer accepts payment for dual credit courses. Payment may be made by credit card, e-check, or through a checking account/routing number.

Asterisk - Students may not choose their instructor when multiple instructors teach a single course. High schools have been pre-assigned to a particular adjunct instructor for organization & communication purposes.

Math courses utilize an online text through Pearson. Families are responsible for the cost of the online textbook in addition to the cost of the course at \$90/CH.
