 - **ALL ONLINE math courses** require the purchase of an online textbook through Pearson MyMathLab.
 - The online math textbook is linked in the student's course syllabus, located in the student's Drury Canvas account. The cost is approximately \$90.
 - No other courses require the purchase of an online textbook.
- ✓ **GPA REQUIREMENT:**
 - **ALL students, freshmen through senior must have a 3.0 GPA.**
 - Students who do not meet the 3.0 GPA are required to complete the DC Permission Form.
 - The form is automatically populated in the student's DualEnroll account when the counselor enters the GPA and it's below 3.0.
 - The DC Permission Form must be signed by all parties and uploaded into the student's DualEnroll account in DOCUMENTS under PROFILE OPTIONS.
