

Summer 2026: Drury Dual Credit Timeline ONLINE courses

**Summer 2026 registration opens Wednesday, April 1, 2026
ONLINE courses start Monday June 1, 2026**

Payment:

- **Payment for summer ONLINE courses** MUST be made at the time of Parent Consent in DualEnroll.
- **Payment options** include credit card or Echeck; service fees apply.
- Payment should be made by Monday, May 25, 2026, so your student is ready to start class on time.
- **The deadline to add/drop (receive a refund) a summer course: Friday, June 5, 2026, at 5 PM.**

IMPORTANT:

- **All MATH courses** require the purchase of a textbook through Pearson MyMathLab.
- The approximate cost of the online textbook is \$90 and is linked in each MATH syllabus.
- **The MDHEWD Scholarship and Panther Fund are NOT available during the summer term.**
- All Drops and Withdrawals occur in the student's DualEnroll account. Counselors are required to approve the drop and/or withdrawal before the student will be officially dropped/withdrawn in Drury's system.
