Please read the following information thoroughly and completed the entire application.

This application is for Athletic Teams and Greek Chapters for funding assistance (maximum of \$500) to support positive and meaningful team-building activities for their respective team or chapter. These activities should be formulated while keeping in mind the values learned in the Captain's and Greek Leader's Retreat. The activities should also reflect the specific components found in each group's Core Covenant. These activities should be well planned, and include specific desired outcomes and results that will benefit the team or chapter as a whole.

Drury University is committed to assisting leaders and captains with the appropriate funding to support these team-building activities. Applications will be reviewed by the Athletic Director and Dean of Students, along with other designated staff members. Following the completion of the funded activity, each team or chapter will submit a reflection and self-evaluation of the event. The Athletic Director and Dean of Students will review these self-assessments, and those that are exemplary will be recognized at the Annual Spring Awards Ceremony.

Applications we be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Quality of application (clear, detailed, and well-written)
- Activity or program is carefully thought out and well planned.
- Development of clear learning outcomes and value/benefit to individuals and team as a whole.
- Activity or program reflects specific components of their Core Covenant.
- Number of members that expected to attend the event.
- Amount of money requested.

Guidelines

- Event must be alcohol free
- Applications must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the program/event date.
- Funds cannot be used to donate to charitable causes or individual organizations (i.e. philanthropies, fundraisers, etc.)

- Grants are awarded on a first come, first come basis, as long as funding is available.
- A written self-assessment should be submitted to the Athletic Director or Dean of Students within 30 days of the completion of the event.
