The following courses are required for the Bachelor of General Studies at Drury University. The remainder of the general-education requirements for the Bachelor of General Studies are satisfied by NorthArk's AGS.

Residency Requirement: The final 30 hours must be earned at Drury University.	
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Drury General-education coursework will be evaluated for transfer. The BS degree requires a minimum of 124 credit hours and 36 upper-division hours. Additional lower-division coursework may be taken at NorthArk, but the final 30 hours must be taken at Drury.

Important: Take English Composition I and II at NorthArk to fulfill the English requirement at Drury.
