Unlike the data used in measure two, these surveys were completed by the first-year teacher themselves, providing their respective educator preparation program (EPP) feedback which can be used to strengthen their program. The results below span over the past three years, comparing the results from Drury completers to the average ratings of other EPPs in Missouri.
