
Employer Satisfaction 2018-20


Conducted by Missouri's Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) and The University of Missouri's Office of Social and Economic Data Analysis (OSEDA), the First-Year Teacher Survey rates new teachers on their effectiveness based on the nine Missouri Teaching Standards. The survey includes 39 questions over the standards with scores ranging from 1 (Strongly Disagree) to 5 (Strongly Agree). Principals of the first-year teacher complete the survey based on their observations and satisfaction with their first-year teacher(s). The following graphs display the averages of Drury compared to other Missouri educator preparation program's first-year teachers based on the nine Missouri Teaching Standards.


